

## Weston Food Service Free Meals Notification

Weston Parents,

The school lunch program this year is operating under the USDA Seamless Summer Option (SSO) program. This federally funded program is approved through June 30, 2021 and allows us to offer free meals to all Weston Public School students.

Free breakfast is offered at Middle and High schools and free lunch is offered throughout the district. Any additional meal or snack purchases must be paid for by the student.

Families in need of additional support must complete a free and reduced application so that, if eligible, they can receive additional P-EBT (Pandemic Electronic Benefit Transfer) benefits.
