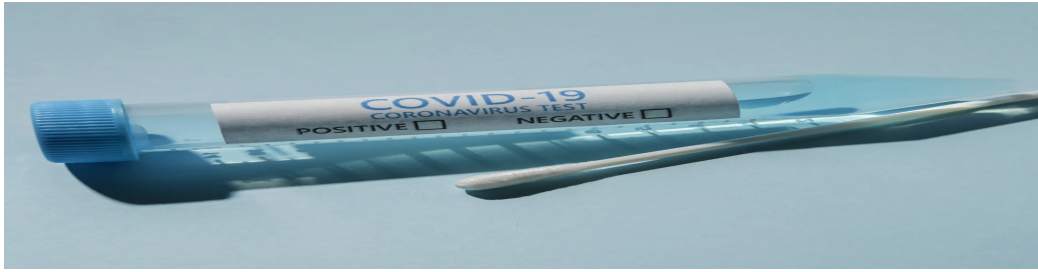

COVID-19 Pooled Testing Program Enrollment and Scheduling Process (March 2021)

Student Registration Information

We are excited to be able to offer Project Beacon COVID-19 Pooled PCR testing for our school community! Here is the process. **New registration links are on page 2:**

Users NEW to Project Beacon -

1. Register in the Project Beacon Online System. Link [here](#) for registration instructions.
2. Consent for asymptomatic Pooled PCR testing is required. The results will be shared with the Department of Public Health and the Weston Board of Health in addition to your building nurse and the Director of Health Services.

Important Reminders

**Families with more than one student should create separate profiles for each student. Instructions can be found [here](#).*

***Families with students who are 18 years of age or older can create a profile for their student, or opt to have their student create his/her own profile.*

Please note: If your student has been diagnosed with COVID-19 within the last 90 days, please DO NOT have your student participate in the weekly pooled testing program until their 90-day window has elapsed. Please contact your building-based school nurse or the Director of Health Services if your student falls into this category.

What Testing Is:

Testing is a glimpse in time and represents the individual's COVID-19 status only at the moment the sample is taken. Testing provides an additional tool in our mitigation toolbox and the opportunity to gain a better understanding of the movement of COVID-19 within Weston and beyond. To date, we have not seen an in-school spread of COVID-19. The more staff/students that participate in our weekly pooled PCR testing the more we will know about the Coronavirus-status of our community.

What Testing Is Not:

It is NOT a safety pass. It does not confer safety, nor does it reduce risk when engaging in social activities. It is NOT permitted to travel or engage in other high-risk activities.

- If you are symptomatic outside of school please continue to follow current WPS Covid-19 protocols to remain home and seek testing through your provider or public testing site. Testing of symptomatic individuals puts school staff, including the nurse, at risk of contracting the virus, and should only be conducted when medically necessary. Please do your part and remain home if you develop symptoms and follow the current procedures for return to school.
- If you develop symptoms while at school. Please continue to follow the current WPS Covid-19 Policy and seek an assessment by your school nurse. If warranted a rapid antigen test will be conducted at this time.
