Dear Field Families:

I hope you enjoyed the February vacation. If you have passed by Field School, you may have noticed scaffolding on the roof and much activity in the parking lot. Over the past week, solar panels have been installed on the rooftop of Field School. This work (supported and implemented by the Sustainability Committee, Weston School Committee, Facilities Department, Permanent Building Committee, and several town staff members) will significantly reduce Weston's climate footprint. The installation is also projected to save the town \$598,000 in electricity costs over the next 20 years.

We will be hosting several events and activities at Field School over the next two months. Our second annual Field Diversity Fair takes place Friday night at 6 PM and will highlight our community's international and cultural diversity. March and April will also feature a game night, multiple concerts, and the 5th grade wax museum! As we move from winter to spring, 5th grade families will be learning more about opportunities and programming at Weston Middle School. Principal John Gibbons will directly contact families early this week about language and music options at the middle school. Please feel free to reach out to him and his staff with any questions you have about the transition to middle school.

On March 5th, we are hosting a principal coffee on the challenges and opportunities that we (and our upper elementary students) experience with social media and associated technology (e.g., iPhones). A brief survey will be sent out to parents this week to learn about questions you have and any areas you would like us to address at the coffee.
