Dear Field Families:

I hope this message finds your family enjoying the long weekend. Last week, the WPS nursing staff performed 345 Covid-19 PCR tests for students and staff across the district. Our Director of Health Services, Jamy Gaynor, has notified us that all tests were negative! This is a clear indication that our mitigation efforts have been successful, even with Covid rates increasing across the state and country. At Field School, I enjoyed seeing (from a distance) so many past and present students walking to the amphitheatre for testing. A message will be going out later today to all parents, which will include details on how to sign-up for testing if you haven't done so already. I want to extend heartfelt thanks to Jamy Gaynor, Jennifer Riggs, and all WPS nurses for their ongoing, herculean efforts to keep students and staff safe. We have an amazing medical team here in Weston! On a health side note, I wanted to share that the state is no longer mandating flu vaccination, as efforts to mitigate Covid-19 have substantially reduced flu rates.
