REMINDER: TRAVEL TESTING REQUIREMENT

This message comes as a reminder of the Weston Public Schools travel requirements. ***Given the current case rates and anticipated travel during the April vacation week, Weston Public Schools will be maintaining the current travel requirement.***

ALL STUDENTS AND STAFF PK-12 WHO TRAVEL OUT OF STATE OVER APRIL BREAK ARE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE PROOF OF NEGATIVE TEST PRIOR TO RETURN. ANY TEST RESULT MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE SCHOOL NURSE PRIOR TO RETURN TO SCHOOL

If you plan to travel out of the country or out of state for greater than 24 hours:

- Individuals who have been completely vaccinated for COVID-19 AND individuals who are COVID-19-recovered do NOT need to provide proof of a negative PCR test or quarantine prior to their return to school unless they have symptoms.
- If you choose not to be tested, you must remain out for 10 full days and may return to school on day 11. You may return to school if you have a negative **Covid-19 PCR/molecular** test.
 - If you choose to complete the 10-day quarantine, the day you return to Massachusetts is day zero and you can return to daily activities on day 11.
- Negative test results should be from a PCR/molecular COVID-19 test (**antigen test results cannot be accepted at this time**).

- You should obtain your Covid-19 PCR/molecular test no earlier than 72 hours prior to your return to the state.
 - For example, if you travel to Florida on Thursday and plan to return the following Monday, the earliest possible test date would be the Friday before your return
