- Families can drop in any time between 4:30-6:00pm.
- Field School Parking Lot will be closed to through traffic. All parking will occur in the Field overflow parking lot and at Country and Woodland Schools.
- Free pizza will be provided by Weston PTO

*There will be NUT-FREE food items at this event.
To ensure safety, all children must be accompanied by an
adult. This is not a drop-off event. Siblings welcome.*

What does it mean to volunteer your trunk?

- 1. Decorate your trunk!** How elaborate you want to be is up to you! Some opt to purchase trunk decorating kits and others prefer to get creative. Examples can be found [here](#).
- 2. Have an activity prepared for children when they come to visit your trunk.** Activities can include purchased or homemade games. Examples can be found [here](#). Activities could also include crafts, such as decorating a mini pumpkin, glitter tattoos, or face painting.
- 3. Arrive at 3:30 and leave at 6:30.** The Parking lot will be closed at 4pm and you will not be able to move your car until after all children have left the parking lot, at 6:30.
- 4. All edible prizes must be NUT-FREE food items that are pre-packaged or non-edible items.** ([Amazon Wishlist link to examples listed below](#))
- 5. Prepare for about 200 visitors to your trunk.** We will have extra candy if our numbers exceed expectations.
- 6. All of your items will be donated (the PTO will NOT reimburse you).**

Other ways to volunteer:

-Fill a teal pumpkin.

We also seek volunteers to fill a teal pumpkin with non-candy treats. A teal pumpkin will be placed at each trunk to ensure that children with food allergies have safe choices available to them. We will make sure to reach out to you with instructions for dropping off your items earlier in the week of the event.
