- You **must** have a teacher recommendation in order to sign up for an honors or AP-level course.
Note: Recommendations are not required for AP Psychology or AP European History.
- **If you would like to take an honors or AP course but were not recommended, you must complete the Override Form** available on the Guidance & Counseling section of the high school website.
- **Override Forms are due March 16, 2018.** *Note: Students should not wait to meet with their counselors before initiating the override form.*
- We are unable to honor teacher requests.
- Students must **register for a minimum of 33.5 credits and provide priorities and alternates** as indicated below.
- Please print clearly **in ink**.
