Here is information on each of these positions:

School Council	Principals Advisory Committee
Weston High School is required by law to form a School Council to advise the Principal on the budget, school disciplinary policies and other matters as arise. Each year, the School Council provides to the School Committee a School Improvement Plan. The School Council meets monthly on the 3rd Thursday, 3-4 pm. Student representatives represent the views of the student body to the School Council; provide minutes from all School Council meetings for the Student Council and Inform the Student Council and Student Issues Committee of important issues facing the School Council.	The Principal's Advisory Council (PAC) includes faculty, staff and students. The PAC meets monthly on the 2nd Thursday, 3-4pm. Student Representatives must attend all Principal's Advisory Council meetings and give input on conflicts and issues involving the student body, faculty, and school administration; provide minutes from all PAC meetings for the Student Council; and the Student Council of important issues facing the PAC.

If you are interested in being a student member of the School Council or the Principal's Advisory Committee, please submit a short statement (no more than 200 words) explaining which position you are interested in, your class year, and why you would like to be selected for the position.
