Fourteen school days until your May 12th ceremonial ‘last day of school’! This will be followed by *ten* more school days, May 15-26, consisting of Senior Internships or Senior Projects. We will then conclude this year with *four* days in June...leading up to Graduation on June 2nd! With all of that said, please make sure you very closely read the following bit of information.

Graduation Date/Time: We look forward to June 2nd at 5:00pm on the Town Green for our annual commencement ceremony. In case of inclement weather, the ceremony will still take place at the **same date and time**, but will move indoors to the middle school. As I have shared personally, in several venues, my daughter is graduating from high school at the exact same time so I will most likely not be in attendance at the WHS commencement ceremony. We will make sure you are in good hands!

Skip Day: Please be reminded that “Skip Days” are not school-sanctioned. As you are aware, if you are a WHS student-athlete, a performer, or are connected with WHS clubs and activities with an event on the day a partial attendance in school is required. As found on page 14 of the school handbook, “Students may participate in an extra-curricular activity on any given school day only if they have been in attendance for a minimum of 3 hours of class time.” *We are pleased to share that there are no athletic games this afternoon and that coaches, directors, teachers have been in communication about this rule prior to today.*

Senior Assassin Game: As is customary amongst many schools across the country, senior classes may get involved with an **off-campus**, non-school sanctioned game, consisting of student targets and water guns. While the school is in no way connected to the game, we are aware that the game may take place.
