

MEDICAL REQUIREMENTS FOR NEW STUDENTS

(For Kindergarten and all new students entering the Weston Public Schools)

CHECKLIST

Immunization Requirements

(in English and signed by the Health Care provider)

- _____ 5 doses of DTP (Diphtheria Tetanus, Pertussis)
- _____ 4 doses of IPV or OPV (Polio)
(Note: 4th dose must be given on or after 4th birthday and \geq 6 months after previous dose or 5th dose is required. 3 doses are acceptable if 3rd dose is given on or after 4th birthday and \geq 6 months after previous dose.)
- _____ 3 doses of Hepatitis B
- _____ 2 doses of MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)
(Note: doses administered before 1st birthday are not valid.)
- _____ 2 doses of Varicella (Chicken Pox vaccine)
(Note: doses administered before 1st birthday are not valid.)
- OR**
- _____ certified reliable history of Chicken Pox disease
- _____ 1 Tdap booster (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis)
(*required for all students entering Grades 7-12)
- _____ Stereopsis Eye Screening (**Kindergarten entry only**)
- _____ Lead Screening Test (**Kindergarten entry only**)

_____ **Health Care Provider Exam & Immunizations**

Your child's physical exam must include up to date immunizations. The Health Care Provider's signature and date of physical must be clearly written. ***(Exam must be within 12 months preceding date of entry.)***

_____ **Annual Nurse Emergency Form**

Please complete *both sides* of this form. It must be signed and dated by parent/guardian. This form is available to download; details below.

Note: forms for the **Health Care Provider's Examination** as well as **Certificate of Immunization** are available to download if your physician does not use standard forms.
