

STUDENT FUND-RAISING ACTIVITIES

In general, the School Committee disapproves of fund-raising in the schools or community by students for school supplies or activities. However, the Committee recognizes that some fund-raising activities may contribute to defraying the cost of valuable school or class projects, including class-wide fundraising efforts related to trips, graduation expenses and similar items. All new fundraising activities must be approved by the Superintendent or his or her designee. As a general rule, students shall not spend academic class time preparing or conducting such fund-raising activities.

The Committee also recognizes that students and student organizations may from time to time engage in fundraising efforts and events to benefit charitable organizations.
