Opening: Presiding, Mr. Henry reviews the agenda, including extra time for public comments. He expressed his concerns on ongoing challenges, and responded to a recently received letter.

- Dr. Connolly highlighted recent student achievements in art, athletics, writing, and [Music](#).
- Ms. Muzila encouraged more families to make [WEEFC](#) donations to support enrichment.
- Ms. Stewart discussed [SEPAC](#), promoting two upcoming speaker events they're hosting.
- Ms. Johnson promoted an upcoming virtual [BWMPO fundraiser 4 P.M. Saturday, Feb 27](#).

### Major Business

- Dr. Connolly contextualizes ongoing challenges with hybrid learning, and shares survey data from students and families regarding the continued expansion of in-person learning.

- Dr. Connolly discusses current priorities regarding hybrid learning, and she introduces the district's most-recent proposals for changes. Key points from current proposals are summarized below, but may be subject to change.
  - **On March 1**, plans to change the WHS schedule to match WMS (8:30am - 1pm). Secondary students will attend alternate Wednesdays in person, w/ existing cohorts.
  - **On March 15**, plans to bring all hybrid students (PK-12) in person 5 days a week. That does not include lunch changes or extension of the school day beyond 1pm.
  - **On April 5**, plans to extend elementary (PK-5) school days to 2:20pm w/ lunch. That does not include lunch or scheduling changes for secondary schools (6-12).
- Community members (both parents and students) gave public comment on the proposal.
- Ass't. Superintendent Matthews summarized the updated budget proposal for FY 2022.
  - Per 2/8 budget hearings, update lowered proposed increase from 2.79% to 2.12%.
- Committee unanimously approved the dissolution of the *EDCO Collaborative*.
- Committee unanimously approved hiring an administrator's child as a part-time Learning Assistant.
- Committee unanimously approved four WEEFC Grants, as well as a regular warrant.
