WESTON METCO REPRESENTATIVE TO THE WESTON SCHOOL COMMITTEE

The Weston School Committee, in addition to its regular members and its Student Advisory Committee member, will have one non-voting representative or two co-representatives (hereafter referred to as the METCO representative) who shall represent families participating in the Weston METCO program. The METCO representative or co-representatives will be authorized to sit at all open sessions of the School Committee and to discuss matters of concern in a fashion similar to school committee members. In addition, the METCO representative or co-representatives may be assigned other responsibilities including committee assignments as determined by the chair of the Weston School Committee.

METCO representatives or co-representatives shall be chosen annually by the Boston Weston METCO Parent Organization (BWMPO) and appointed by the Weston School Committee for a one-year term. The selection process shall be determined by the BWMPO in keeping with its bylaws. The METCO representative or co-representative will be eligible for re-nomination and reappointment to subsequent terms. If a vacancy occurs, the officers of the BWMPO may nominate a person for appointment to complete the unexpired term.
