

SCHOOL COMMITTEE REVIEW OF ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS

The Superintendent is charged with the responsibility of implementing policies established by the School Committee. The Superintendent shall establish administrative regulations necessary for this implementation. New or revised regulations shall be reviewed and approved by the School Committee to determine consistency with the intent of the policy. Regulations shall be deemed to be in force upon School Committee approval of the Superintendent's recommendation. In the absence of approved regulations, the Superintendent shall exercise his/her judgment and act in accordance with School Committee policy CHD, Administration in Policy Absence.

Rules Pertaining to Staff and Student Conduct

Under Massachusetts law, the Superintendent is required to publish "rules and regulations pertaining to the conduct of teachers and students which have been adopted." (Codes of discipline, as well as procedures used to develop such codes shall be filed with the State Department of Elementary and Secondary Education for information purposes only.) Standards of conduct will be included in staff and student handbooks.
