

TRAFFIC AND PARKING REGULATIONS

The School Committee and Recreation Commission (the Boards) have agreed to adopt the following parking regulations for all school and recreation grounds:

1. The School Committee and Recreation Commission, or any person authorized by said Boards, may prescribe regulations governing the operation of motor vehicles on school or recreation property respectively, including the designation of temporary and permanent parking areas and restrictions. Specific parking spaces or areas may be designated for the exclusive use of faculty/staff, students, visitors, Recreation Commission staff and patrons, or vendors and contractors working on School Committee or Recreation Commission property. All parking areas and restrictions shall be designated by signage indicating, where appropriate, such information as the authorized users, the authorized hours of availability of the designated parking spaces and the permissible duration of parking.
2. As of the date of this policy, the said Boards hereby ratify and approve all permanent and temporary parking designations and signage currently located on any property under their care, custody and control.
3. For the purposes of this regulation, the Principal of each individual school shall be authorized to designate temporary and permanent parking spaces and areas at his/her respective School.
4. For purposes of this regulation, "signage" shall include, but not be limited to:
 - i. Signs, posters and/or notices of any color, configuration, shape, material or size;
 - ii. Signs, posters and/or notices of a temporary, portable or permanent nature;
 - iii. Any and all painted stripes, lines, crosswalks, yellow curbs and/or other such markings;
5. In the event of construction on any School Committee or Recreation Commission property, temporary parking restrictions or required parking areas may be designated by the Director of Facilities, the Recreation Director or their respective authorized designee(s), including any other official appointed by the said Boards with the specific responsibility of control of vehicular traffic on the property. If the school building or recreational facility is occupied or in use during a construction project, the Superintendent, or his/her authorized designee, shall consult with the affected School Principal(s) or Recreation Director with respect to the designation of all parking restrictions, however, the Superintendent or designee shall retain the final authority to determine appropriate parking restrictions during such construction project in order to assure the safety of persons and property. Any such parking restrictions shall be posted with appropriate temporary signage, and may from time to time be relocated at the discretion of the said official as he/she deems necessary in the interest of project efficiency and safety. Any person wishing to modify any such restriction shall obtain the prior written approval of the Superintendent or designee, or his/her authorized designee, before changing any previously established parking restrictions.
6. Any parking restrictions authorized under these regulations may be enforced by any member of the Weston Police Department, including any persons designated as Special Police Officers.
7. Any parking citations issued pursuant to these regulations shall conform to standard parking enforcement procedures and be processed in the same manner as parking citations generally throughout the Town.

8. If any term or condition of these regulations or any parking restriction established pursuant hereto shall to any extent be held invalid, illegal or unenforceable by the court of competent jurisdiction, the validity, legality, and enforceability of the remaining terms and parking restrictions of these regulations shall not be deemed affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect.
