

MATERIAL RESOURCES MANAGEMENT

All equipment, materials, and supplies are to be considered part of and belonging to the entire Weston Public School system regardless of the original purchaser or location of housing. Equipment and materials and supplies purchased by a particular school or school unit through the annual school budget will remain more or less in the sole possession of that school unit while it has definite use for the resource.

When the resources become surplus or no longer useful in a particular school unit, they become readily available for use in other school units within the Weston Public Schools.

The Superintendent is authorized, with the permission of the Selectmen, to dispose of obsolete or surplus material resources by giving such resources to other public schools or by public sale using methods consistent with local bylaws and/or state law.
