

STUDENT VOLUNTEERS FOR SCHOOL AND PUBLIC SERVICE

The Committee encourages the use of student volunteers in the educational program (e.g. student librarians, student office helpers, tutors, etc.) and in useful community services. However, student volunteers must be capable of carrying the additional load without endangering their academic achievement. Therefore, all student volunteers shall be expected to maintain their grades, attend all classes, and recognize that the activity to which they are volunteering their services is secondary to their primary goal of getting an education.

Teachers' advisors and members of the community are encouraged to check with the guidance counselor and the Principal before students are sought for volunteer help, to make sure that the students can afford academically to undertake the additional responsibility.

All student volunteer supervisors are subject to the requirements of the CORI policy.
