

ASSIGNMENT OF STUDENTS TO SCHOOLS

Students entering the Weston Public Schools in grades Pre-K through 3 will be assigned to Woodland School or Country School in a manner determined by the Superintendent. Whenever possible, school assignments for new students will be made only after individual screenings with each student. Assignment will be based on a combination of factors, including:

1. Whether a student has a disability for which a particular school has a program;
2. Siblings;
3. Maintaining a gender balance in the classroom and between the schools;
4. Class size;
5. Chronological age; and
6. If practicable, providing a familiar face for each child in their classroom.
