

## ENTRANCE AGE

In an attempt to permit children to enter kindergarten at the time most appropriate for them individually, the Weston School Committee establishes the following policy on entrance age:

1. Children who will be five years of age before September 1 of the school year during which they wish to enroll will be eligible to enter kindergarten in September.

The admission of children whose birthdays fall on or after September 1 shall be solely at the discretion of the Superintendent or the Superintendent's designee. The Superintendent's or designee's consideration may include chronological age and academic, social, and emotional preparedness.

2. Initial admission of children to the first grade (or other grades) shall involve a consideration of chronological age, past school experience, and the readiness of the children to do the work of those grades.
