

MINUTES OF WESTON SCHOOL COMMITTEE MEETING

Field School  
May 30, 2019

A meeting of the Weston School Committee was called to order at 8:05 AM at the Field School Library by Mr. John Henry, Chair. In attendance were Ms. Danielle Black, Vice Chair, Mr. Alex Cobb, Ms. Anita Raman and Ms. Rachel Stewart of the School Committee; Dr. Midge Connolly, Superintendent; and Dr. J. Kimo Carter, Assistant Superintendent for Teaching and Learning.

Also present were Dr. Dan Green, Field School Principal, Ms. Erin Maguire, Country School Principal, and members of the Field School Council.

Mr. Henry welcomed everyone, introduced members of the School Committee and Administration, and reviewed the agenda.

Presentation of School Improvement Plan (SIP)

Dr. Green first discussed his transition to his leadership role as principal of the Field School becoming a part of the Field School community. Dr. Green then discussed progress on initiatives under the Field School 2018-2019 SIP, including a focus on social and emotional learning through the implementation of responsive classroom, a democratic process for selecting schoolwide rules and new routines and procedures. Dr. Green also discussed improving connectivity with families through additional PTO events, communication and websites, as well as implementation of the Lucy Calkins writing curriculum and Data Wise.

Dr. Green then discussed goals of the Field School under its 2019-2020 SIP, including expanded responsive classroom and social and emotional learning implementation; a math workshop; Data Wise with a focus on social and emotional learning and the math workshop; and additional outreach to families through PTO, communications and access to school.

Dr. Green then responded to questions from the room concerning the math workshop, use of data in teaching and assessment and the successful implementation of a coach at the school.
