

MINUTES OF WESTON SCHOOL COMMITTEE MEETING
Weston Middle School
May 9, 2019

A meeting of the Weston School Committee was called to order at 7:45 AM at the Weston Middle School Library by Mr. John Henry, Chair. In attendance were Ms. Danielle Black, Vice Chair and Ms. Rachel Stewart, members of the school committee; Dr. Midge Connolly, Superintendent; and Dr. J. Kimo Carter, Assistant Superintendent for Teaching and Learning. Not attending: Mr. Alex Cobb and Ms. Anita Raman of the school committee.

Also present were Mr. John Gibbons, Middle School Principal; and members of the Middle School Council.

Mr. Henry welcomed everyone, introduced members of the School Committee and Administration, and reviewed the agenda.

Presentation of School Improvement Plan (SIP)

Mr. Gibbons first provided an update on progress made in the current year with regard to on-going initiatives under the SIP, including work of the data analysis team, instructional coaches, power math and topics classes, differentiated learning team, implementation of Google classroom, the Transitions program, ALICE training, and unity day. Mr. Gibbons then presented additional initiatives to be added during the 2019-2020 school year, including further implementation of responsive classroom, introducing a multi-grade advisory program, the Sources of Strength program and a school climate survey. The committee then discussed a number of aspects of the plan, including instructional coaches, math topics, the Transitions program and the data analysis team.
