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Woodland School, pre-school through grade three, is a place where children are encouraged to wonder about the world around them and to share their thoughts respectfully with one another. Woodland’s mindset for learning isn't about adding a new curriculum, but rather rethinking the curriculum we already have in ways that support flexibility, resilience, optimism, empathy, and persistence. For our students, sometimes taking on the habits of mind means displacing old habits and replacing them with new ones. When children view mathematics as right or wrong, they will only feel successful when they’ve made the fewest mistakes. This view of learning keeps children from being free to explore and take chances and risks- for fear of being wrong. When mistakes are viewed as learning opportunities, our children can take more risks and think in innovative ways. As we explore the habits of mind in our classes, we are hoping to gift students with important thinking tools that they need for life! Teachers and staff model these attributes, and children find many ways to demonstrate their own growth in becoming authentic lifelong learners.

- Teachers participated in Culturally Responsive Teaching professional sessions and began the reflection process of one’s own beliefs.
